- Local Government Act 2002

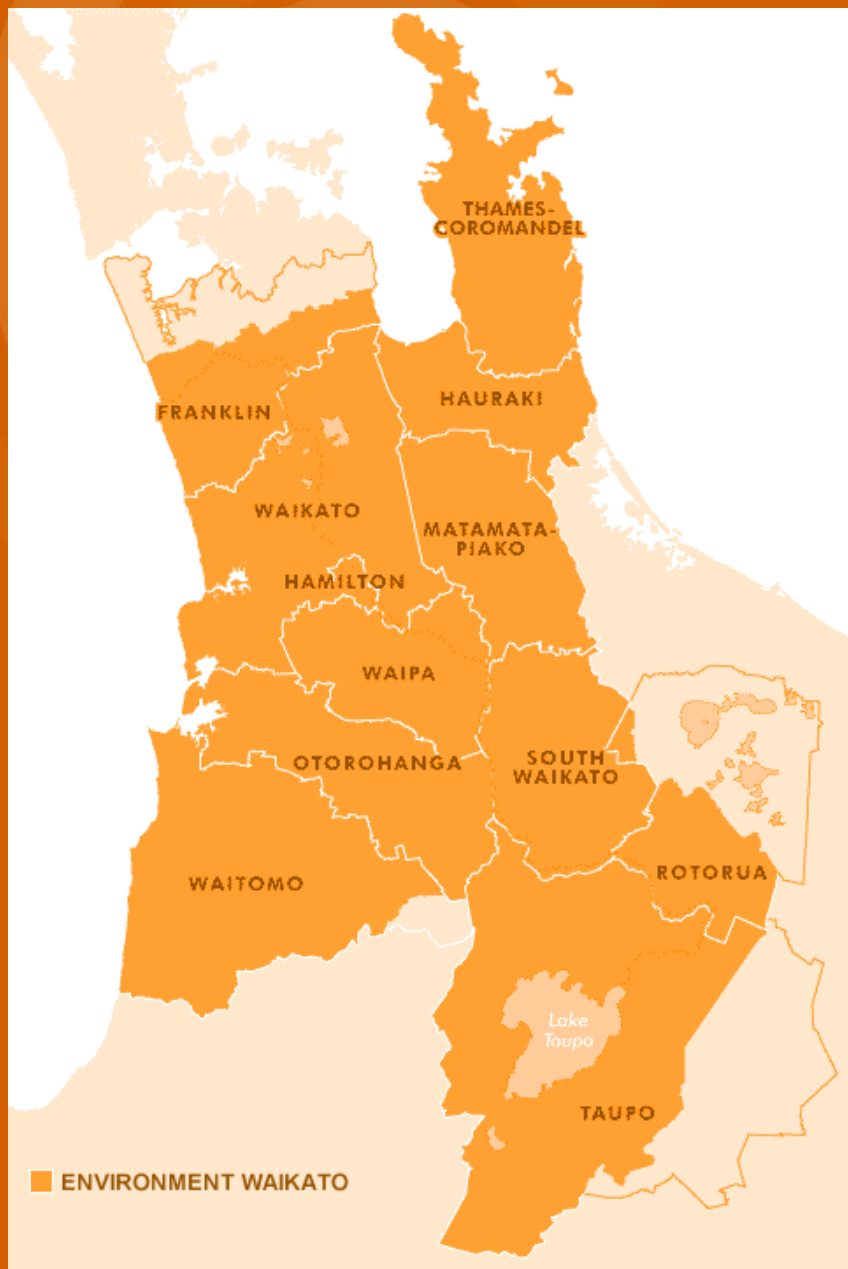
Choosing Futures Waikato is...

Iwi approach

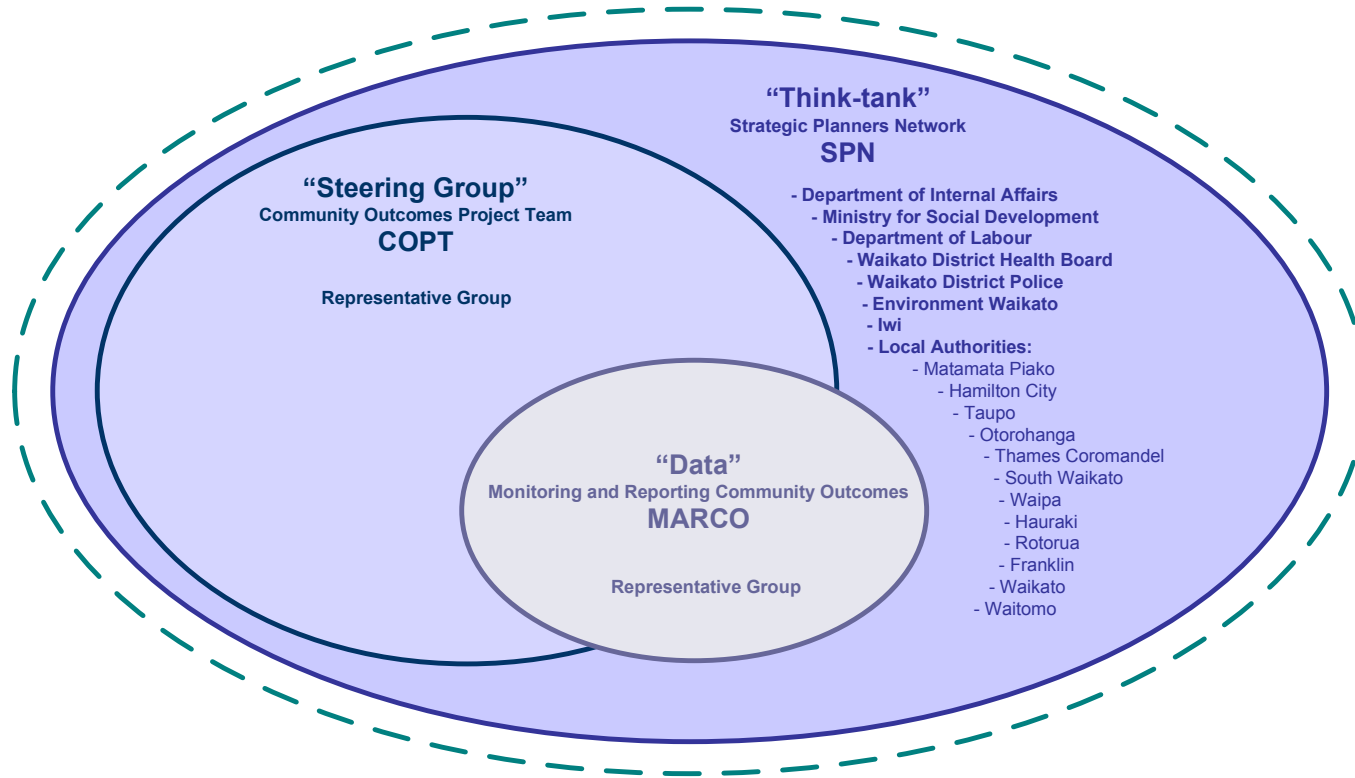
- Iwi participated in drafting regional community outcomes
- implemented a parallel process to identify Iwi specific Outcomes
- Subsequently, Waikato - Tainui, Maniapoto, and Raukawa identified Community Outcomes
- Hauraki & Tuwharetoa aspirations referenced in Iwi Management plans
- Iwi community outcomes incorporated into region's Long Term Community Council Plan (LTCCP) 2006-2016

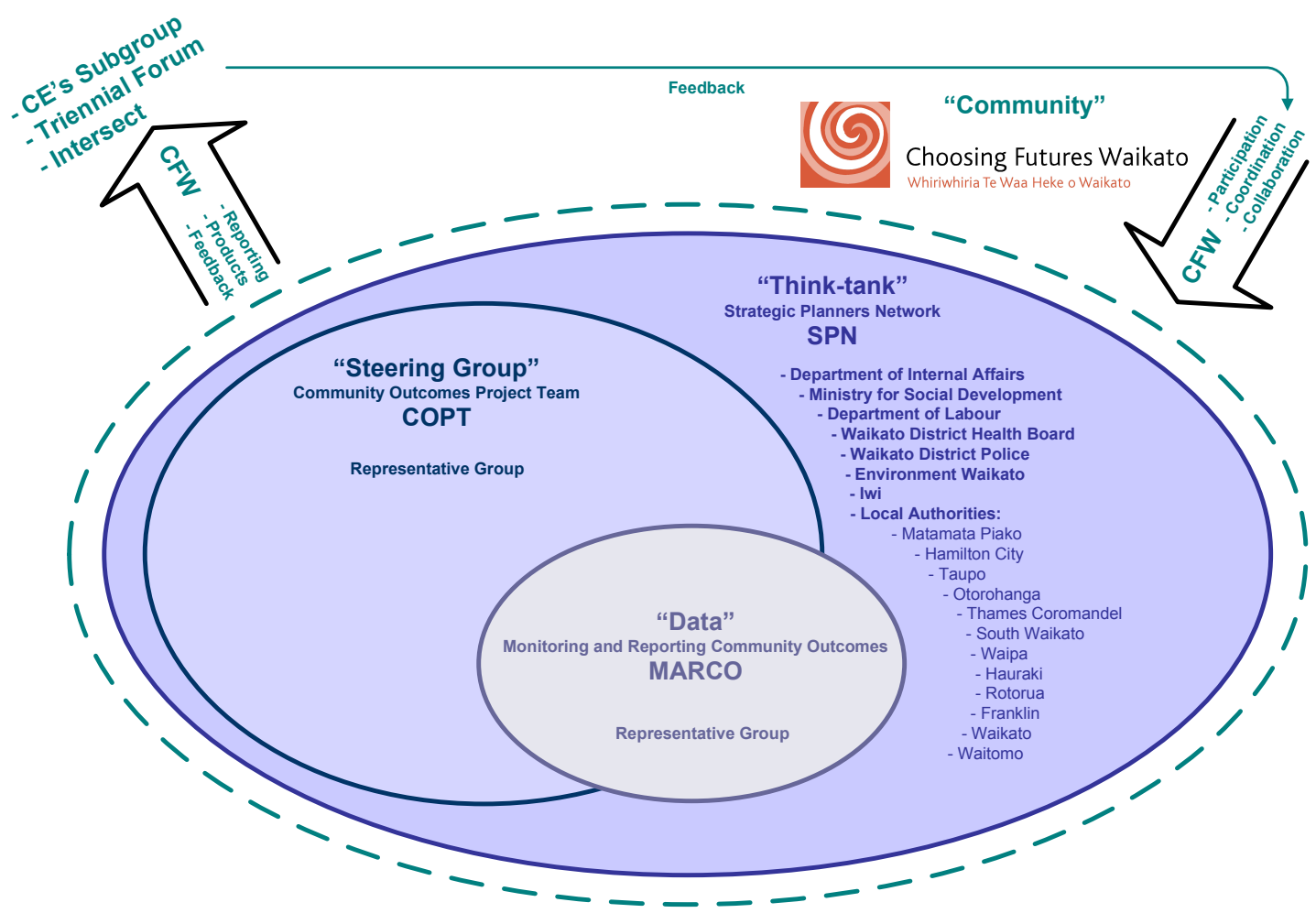


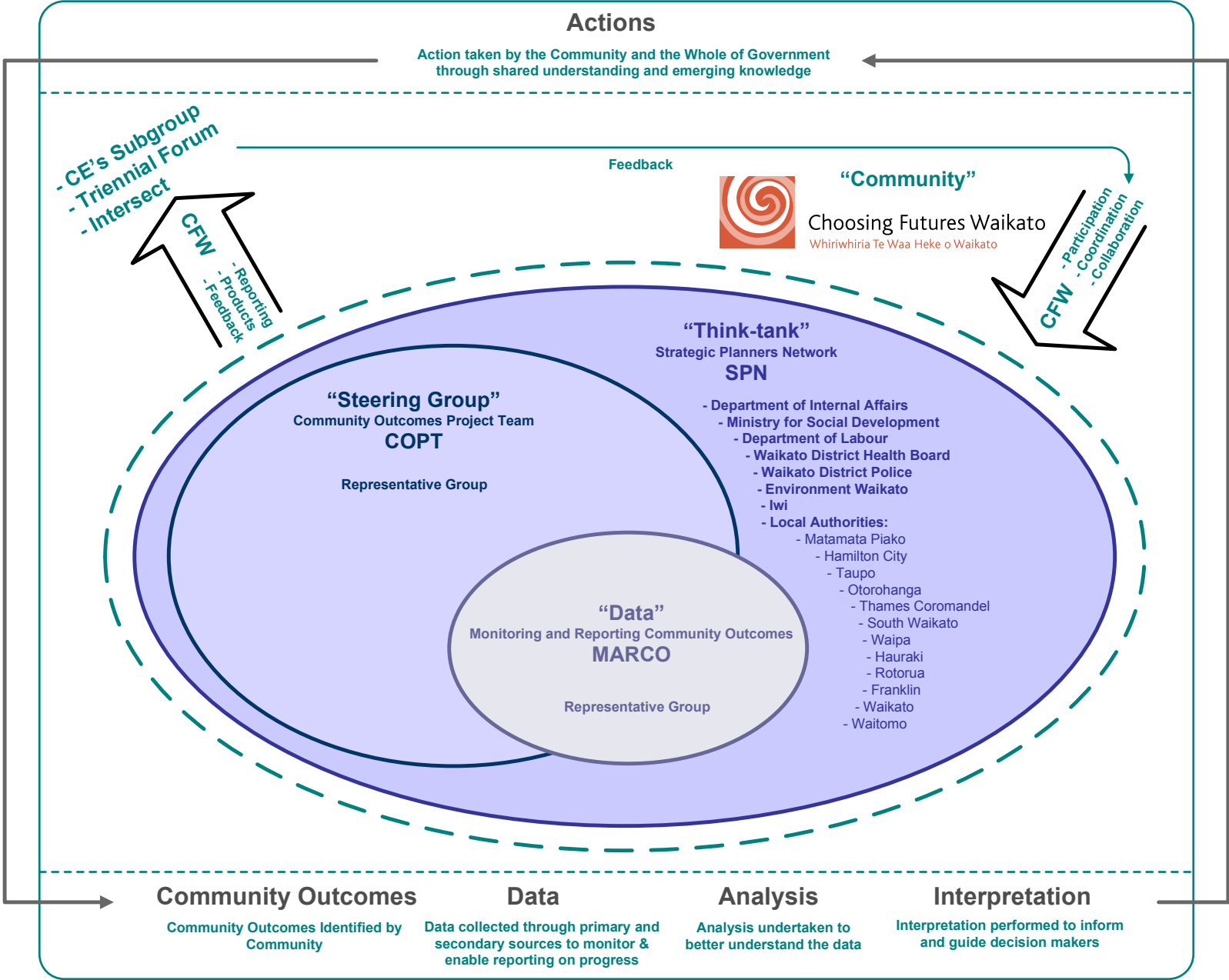

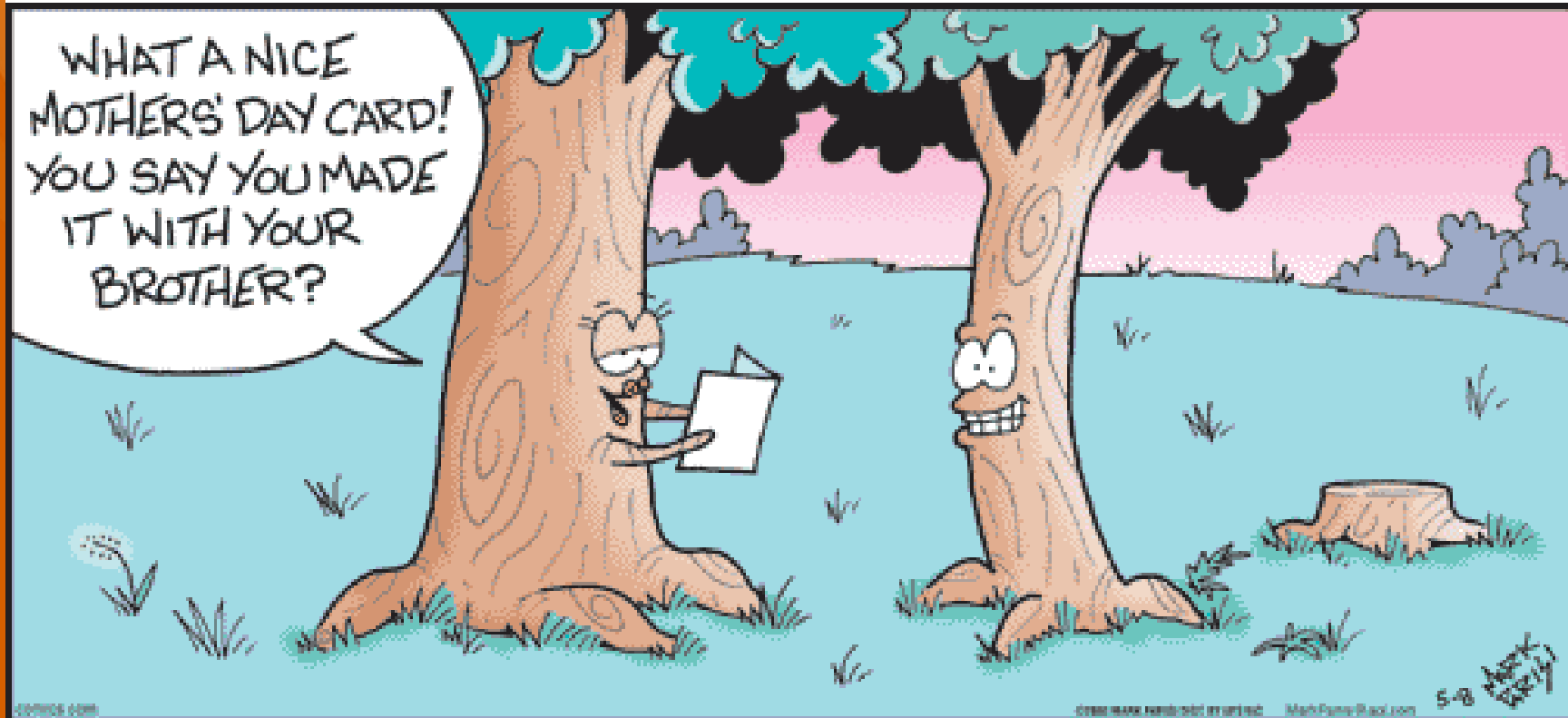
