

Peninsula's common aspirations still on track

A recent review shows the Peninsula's communities' aspirations for the future remains relevant.

Choosing Futures Thames-Coromandel feedback forms were posted, online, in libraries and at Council offices.

The majority that responded told Thames-Coromandel District Council (TCDC) the Choosing Futures Thames-Coromandel goals were still what they wanted for the Peninsula.

Choosing Futures are identified aspirations for our district - a common vision for individuals, community groups and government agencies alike to work towards together.

Choosing Futures was developed after extensive community consultation in 2006. The community vision for the future reflects the Peninsula's natural environment, special character and community spirit.

TCDC facilitated the review of the Choosing Futures Thames-Coromandel as required (at least six yearly) under the Local Government Act 2002. Council considered the results and endorsed keeping the Choosing Futures statements.

The recent review of the Choosing Futures was a 'check-in' exercise. Other consultation projects, including the Coromandel Peninsula Blueprint Project, had also suggested the community's ideals were still relevant.
